RESOLVED: That the Board of School Directors of the Penn Cambria School District, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of Section 679 of the School Code of 1949 P.L. 30, and its supplements and amendments, declares that the resolution by which a per capital tax had been levied for the school fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, for general school purposes in the sum of FIVE (\$5.00) DOLLARS upon each and every person residing in the Penn Cambria School District of the age of eighteen (18) years and over is hereby re-enacted without change for the school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015.

RE-ENACTMENT ACT 511 TAXES

MILLAGE LEVY FOR 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR

RESOLVED: The Penn Cambria School District Board of Directors, in Regular Session assembled, that for the purpose of providing revenue for said district for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, a tax of fifty-two and eighty-two hundredths (52.82) mills or \$5.282 per \$100 of assessed valuation, of all property in said district upon which Cambria County tax is levied and assessed. Properties within the District lying in Blair County shall be taxed at seventy-three and eighty-one hundredths (73.81) mills or \$7.381 per \$100 of assessed valuation. These mill rates are in compliance with Section 24 of the Public School Code 6-672.1 (re-balancing). This resolution adopted this 20th day of May, 2014.

HOMESTEAD/FARMSTEAD EXCLUSION

RESOLVED: by the Board of Directors of Penn Cambria School District, that homestead and farmstead exclusion real estate tax assessment reductions are authorized for the school year beginning July 1, 2014, under the provisions of the Homestead Property Exclusion Program Act (part of Act 50 of 1998) and the Taxpayer Relief Act (Act 1 of 2006).
