College Opportunity for PCHS Seniors in the Class of 2020

Are you interested in taking a college course at Mount Aloysius College during the 2019-2020 school year? A partnership between Mount Aloysius and the Penn Cambria School District will allow you the opportunity to attend Mount Aloysius in Cresson and take a course or two at a discounted cost. You must meet these basic requirements to be eligible:

- 1. Have all graduation requirements completed or scheduled at Penn Cambria
- 2. Have an overall grade point average above an 85%
- 3. Provide your own transportation to and from Mount Aloysius
- 4. Pay the reduced tuition cost of \$250/credit or \$750 per course (approximately 70% savings)

Students can take courses in place of 1st or 4th period electives, enroll in a class independently after the PCHS school day, or schedule an online course. A list of possible courses for the **Fall of 2019** is listed below. Please note that individual options may vary based on courses scheduled at PCHS to meet your graduation requirements.
