Good morning,

As I'm sure most of you are aware, the Governor announced yesterday afternoon that Pennsylvania schools are closed indefinitely. No one knows what "indefinitely" means but as we've been doing throughout this crisis, we will manage operations day to day and week to week.

I've been in communication with the Board members and we are planning to schedule a Board meeting for Tuesday, April 7th. The committee meeting will be held at 6 PM and the voting meeting will follow at 6:30 pm. The agenda includes an item to finalize this year's calendar so our families know when the 2019-2020 school year will officially end. There will be a public announcement in the papers as to the meeting date, location, and format.

The District is committed to our current Continuity of Education Plan. We may be revising aspects of the plan as this school year continues, but we will continue to communicate with you daily if needed. Please share with others that all of my updates are available on the COVID-19 section of the district website under Superintendent's Updates.

I also wanted to share that a 911 call went out late yesterday afternoon that there was a structure fire at PC Middle School. A staff member was shutting down the coal furnace and it was creating a lot of black smoke. There was no fire. However, we really appreciate the fact that community members are helping us watch over our schools and contacting 911 when they see something of concern. Thank you!
