Good Morning,

As of 3/19/20 at 10:30 am we have still not received word on the approval of the waiver to offer grab and go lunches to our children submitted on 3/16/20 from the PA Department of Education. Therefore, we will start offering these meals using individual donations until we receive waiver approval. Grab and Go meals will be available to any child 18 and under as noted below.

All distributions will take place at Penn Cambria High School 401 Linden Avenue Cresson, PA in the back circle from 11:00 AM – 12:00 PM.

Distribution Dates

FRIDAY 3/20/20 - will include Lunch for Friday and Breakfast & Lunch for Saturday & Sunday and Breakfast for Monday

MONDAY 3/23/20 - will include Lunch for Monday and Breakfast & Lunch for Tuesday & Wednesday and Breakfast for Thursday

THURSDAY 3/26/20 – will include Lunch for Thursday, Breakfast and Lunch for Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Breakfast for Monday

Families may stay in their vehicles and bagged meals will be delivered to you. Children **must** be present in the vehicle. Students/families may also walk to the site. Door Letter N will be used for distribution. Please use caution if you are driving as there may be children and families walking to the site and please do not congregate at the location.

We had had an overwhelming number of faculty, staff, and community members who volunteered to help. These offers just confirm the community spirit we know exists within our district. However, we will have only a very limited number of staff and volunteers assisting in order to comply with recommendations for limited interactions.

Also, the Mount Aloysius College Mission and Ministry Department will be distributing donated food such as cereal bars, fruits, soup, and oatmeal to any student/family in our area. This distribution will also occur on **Friday, March 20**th **from 11:00 am – 12:30 pm** (or until supplies run out) at the back circle of the high school. Please share this information with any of your family, friends, or neighbors who may need a little extra help right now.
