Letter U

When forming the letter U: start at the top line, go down, touch the bottom line and go back up to the top

When forming the letter u: start at middle line, go down touch the bottom line and back up to the middle, then small down

Practice with your finger in the air, like we do at circle!

Using string or yarn make the letter u.

What other letters can you make with string?

TRY S, C, O, J, L, P

Make the letter U in the air with your finger like we do at circle time! Now write your name in the air!

The letter U makes two sounds...its name U and u like the alphablock!

Words that start with U: umbrella, ugly, unicorn..

Sorting

Using any toys you may have, try to have your preschooler sort them in piles. If you have Legos you could sort by color, or by how many bumps they have. Try sorting matchbox cars or trucks by color. If you have beads, blocks, buttons, or any toys!

Questions to ask:

Which color has the most? Which color has the least? Do any of the colors have the same number?
