<p><u>Hide and Seek Words</u> Have someone write the high frequency words on pieces of paper and hide them. When you find them, you have to read them!</p>	<p><u>Apple Tree Math</u> Draw and color a tree. Cut some red and green apples. Put some of each on the tree and write/read the number sentence to match.</p>	<p><u>SPRING Writing</u> Print letters S-P-R-I-N-G down the side of paper. Write three words that start with each letter.</p>
<p><u>Egg and Spoon</u> Get a spoon and try to balance a hard boiled or plastic egg as you walk from one point to another. Go fast. Dance. Race another family member!</p>	<p><u>Spring Art</u> Draw a picture that shows the season of Spring. If nice, use chalk and go outside!</p>	<p><u>Weather Reporter</u> Keep track of the weather by drawing a picture for each day of the week. Circle your favorite one!</p>
<p><u>Story Time</u> Read a book with an adult. Talk about the new words you heard. Talk about the beginning, middle and end.</p>	<p><u>Ten Frame Game</u> Make cards with ten on for numbers 0-10. Make cards with numbers 0-10. Play a matching game. Challenge yourself with numbers 11-20!</p>	<p><u>Sentence Writing</u> Try to write a sentence using three of your high frequency words. Make sure it starts with capital and ends with a stopping mark. Draw a picture to match.</p>
