Is the story being told 1<sup>st</sup> person, 2<sup>nd</sup> person or 3<sup>rd</sup> person?</p>	<p><b><u>Graphing:</u></b> Use jellybeans or other types of candy in your Easter basket to make a bar graph or pictograph. Or you could call your friends or family to ask them what their favorite Easter candy is and graph that.</p>
<p><b><u>Multiplication:</u></b> TOWER POWER! You will need 10 cups (dixie or plastic) and a marker. Create your own tower by writing multiplication facts on the bottom of the cups. (Use the multiplication fact families- x7, x8, and x9's). After facts are on the cups, put them in one standing stack. Directions: Pick the cup on the top on the stack, answer the problem, start building your tower. You should have 4 cups on the bottom, then 3, then 2, and 1 on top!
