



Kindergarten Learning Activities – Due May 8, 2020



Each week, students are **required to complete the two reading and math activities on this page**. Share work with your child's teacher on Class Dojo Message or email, each week, for promotion to first grade. Mandatory Reading Activities

1. HF Words **that/give**: Write each word on piece of paper and hang them in the house somewhere. Practice reading these two words with your helper. Every time you pass those in the house this week shout out the words. (put them somewhere you pass often) Find these words (or letters in magazines or newspaper) to cut out and make these words. Tape or glue to your paper.

2. Long Vowel O- Silent e: Read to your child: Remember when you add a silent /e/ to the end of a word, it makes the vowel in front of it say it's name. The /e/ is silent and says nothing.

* Write these words on paper, chalkboard or white board as someone reads them to you: home, bone, nose, robe, hope, note
*Go back and underline the /o/ in each word and practice saying it's name really loud.

* Read the words. Remember, the /o/ will say it's name and the /e/ is silent. You will not make any sound for /e/. Circle all the words you read correctly.

* Complete the worksheet!

Mandatory Math Activities

1. Shapes: 3D shapes are fat not flat! A **CONE** is like a party hat. A **SPHERE** is like a ball. A **CYLINDER** is like a can. A **CUBE** is like a block. Walk around your house and find things that are shaped like the 3D shapes above. Fold a paper into four boxes. Write the 3D name and draw one thing you found for each.

2. Addition and Subtraction: Find a small item to help you complete the adding and subtracting problems on the worksheet. You can use cereal or goldfish. You can even draw a picture if you can't find items. Make sure you read the sentences correctly "five plus two equals seven" or "six minus one equals five". Complete the addition/subtraction worksheet.
