Letter Z

When forming the letter Z: start on the top line slide forward, slant back and touch the bottom line, slide forward

When forming the letter Z: start on the middle line slide forward, slant back and touch the bottom line, slide forward

Make the letter Z in the air with your finger like we do at circle time! Now write your name in the air!

Words that use the letter Z: zoo, zebra, Can you think of anymore?

It is ok if they cannot come up with their own words, just give

them some to practice with you ${\it oldsymbol {eta}}$

Language and Literacy Activities

- Using the book sent home, find the Letter Z page, help your child find words that use the letter Z.
- If you have post it notes this could be done on a wall like in the picture. If not no worries! Any paper, note cards,etc.... I have seen it done with paper plates on the floor, just putting the ABC in order in whatever way you can, will help!



MATH ACTIVITIES:

1. Using legos, or blocks see if your preschooler can recreate something you have made! You do not need to draw or print anything! Just make your own building and have them try to recreate.

This helps with special relations, recognizing colors, and process building skills!

2. Since we already have the legos/blocks out, count how many you use in each building. Maybe see how tall/how many blocks you can use at one time!

What kind of animal is Stellaluna? She is a bat. Who is she living with? Birds! What does Stellaluna do different than the birds? She doesn't like eating bugs, she hangs upside down. What happens when the baby birds and Stellluna go flying?

Stellaluna flew too far away and the baby birds go home without her. Who finds Stellaluna? Bats, and her mother finds her and teach her that she is a bat!

To summarize the ending....discuss how Stellaluna and the birds are different but still friends.
