\*Tip from our Speech teacher, Mrs.McMullen: Mirror, Mirror On the Wall Modeling is an important piece of any speech therapy program and parents can get in on the fun by helping their children learn how to properly pronounce by using a mirror. Choose a few words that are challenging them and demonstrate by moving your mouth slowly as you say the word to say them. Then, let your child speak in front of a mirror so they can see how to move their mouth to make certain sounds. Get silly and include plenty of onomatopoeias like buzz, moo, roar, and meow.
