This report summarizes the actions taken by the Penn Cambria Board of Education at its special meeting, October 29, 2020.

- I. HEARING OF VISITORS – Ed Watt, Gallitzin, stated that as a parent of three students, he would like to see students return to back in school, as well as the teachers deemed essential workers. With that being said, he made one suggestion in regard to the hybrid schedule, to switch the “B” group to go face to face on Monday and Tuesday rather than Thursday and Friday.

Mr. Marshall, Superintendent, responded that this topic will be discussed in executive session.

- II. The Board of Directors entered into Executive Session to discuss safety matters.
