- Districtwide repairs/maintenance related to air flow and ventilation

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Window/Door Project \$570,000 Planned High School window and door replacements

Absences and Staff Shortages

- **Substitute coverage** for COVID-related absences 21-22 & 22-23 = \$30,630
- Class coverage for staff working during preparation time due to nationwide staff and substitute shortages as result of pandemic 21-22 & 22-23 = \$112,500

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Technology \$21,460

Filtering software for laptops being used remotely

 Canvas LMS for MS/HS – 2 years (22-23 & 23-24)

Science Textbooks \$75,000

- New science textbook series grades 3-8
- Curriculum improvement to help accelerate learning in response to pandemic
- Pandemic showed that students were in need of textbook for support, especially when absent. Current textbooks do not provide online access or resources.

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Quarantine Support \$27,710

• Extra duty for staff members providing support for students and families missing school due to quarantine or isolation.

Social, Emotional, Mental Health Supports

- Mental Health Counseling = \$121,550
 - Partial funding for Impact Counseling (or comparable service provider) 21-22 plus funding for 22-23 and 23-24
- School Social Worker = \$71,300
 - In-district travel, supplies, remainder of salary/benefits for 23-24
- PD for Threat Assessment Teams = \$500

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Middle School

- MS Assistant Principal = \$259,888
 - Partial Year Spring 2022
 - 2022-2023
 - 2023-2024

Middle School students and families have been hard hit by the pandemic. Students are struggling to cope with returning to school. Behavioral and academic struggles are prevalent. Staff, students and families are in need of additional support.

COVID Health Supports \$34,799

- Extra duty hours for nurses
- PPE and cleaning supplies
- CPR/First Aid for staff

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PC Cyber Academy
