Applications are now available for the 2026 Jacob Campbell Scholarships, presented by Alma Lodge #523. Two (2) \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors attending high school in Cambria County. Students must be planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution (college, trade school, technical school). Last year we had 34 applications from every school district in Cambria County. One winner last year was from Central Cambria and the other was from Admiral Perry/Penn Cambria.

The Jacob Campbell Scholarship winners will be selected by a committee, made up of members of Alma Lodge #523. Applications are available from high school guidance counselors, online at [222.almalodge523.org](http://222.almalodge523.org), or by calling 814-536-8341 and requesting a copy. Applications must be postmarked by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 to be considered. NO EXCEPTIONS!! Winners will be contacted and will be posted on the lodge website.

**ABOUT JACOB CAMPBELL:** Jacob Campbell was born in 1821. Though raised in Pennsylvania, Campbell traveled across the United States, before settling in Johnstown. He began his military career in 1861, eventually being brevetted a Brigadier-General. After a successful military career, Campbell served four (4) terms as a Congressman in the United States House of Representatives for Pennsylvania's 17<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. Campbell was a charter member and the very first Noble Grand of Alma Lodge #523. He also served a Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania.

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**Jacob Campbell Scholarships Rules and Information**

- A minimum of two (2) \$3,000 scholarship winners will be selected. Additional scholarships may be awarded at the desecration of the scholarship committee.
- Scholarship is open to all high school seniors who attended a Cambria County high school.
- Applicants must be attending an accredited post-secondary institution following high school graduation (college, trade school, technical school).
- Applications will be made available starting in February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.
- Completed applications, including any necessary attachments, must be postmarked by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
- The Scholarship Committee, made up of members of Alma Lodge #523, will review the applications. Winners will be contacted and their names announced once they accept the award. Winners will be invited to attend an Awards Ceremony, held at Alma Lodge #523, where they will be presented with their scholarship.
